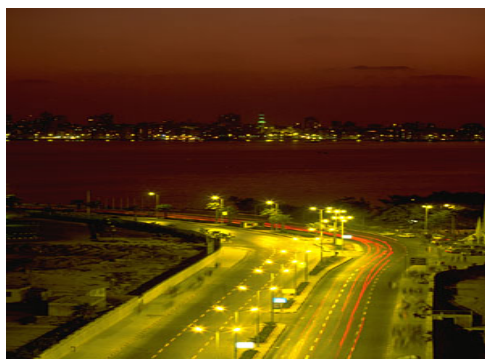

Once again Cal Grad is pioneering the Doctor of Ministry Program by designing the courses around approved conferences such as those conducted by Leadership Nexus (www.leadershipnexus.net), Saddleback Church events, Catalyst or Thrive conferences.

HOW IT WORKS

Students are required to read one book written by each of four main presenters. Following that, the student will write and turn in to the mentor a reflection paper on each of the books read.

At the conferences attended, the student will again write reflection papers on each of those same speakers with the addition of how their teaching impacts the student in ministry. Students will attend an Intensive in California at which time Cal Grad faculty will instruct them further on areas of education, spirituality and leadership.

SPEAKERS/TEACHERS

The speakers chosen for the conferences attended, whatever approved Conference that may be, are among the top speakers and successful leaders of today's ministries. Students are encouraged to listen intently to pick up the TOOLS FOR MINISTRY which the speakers will freely give. Wise application of this information to the student's personal life, ministry and dissertation or project will be measured in the writings.

DISSERTATION/PROJECT

A 150-page dissertation or project is required for graduation from this program. Students are guided from the beginning to write parts of their work to give them clear guidance on the writing of the dissertation. The dissertation or project is the crown of the program and student pride should be evident in the work completed. The School has strict guidelines for writing. Quality time in the Intensives held in California will center on dissertation writing so students are clear about the direction they need to go.
